## Trifold Shutter Card

1. Place cardstock $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ in paper trimmer, landscape position and score at $2^{\prime \prime}, 4 " 8^{\prime \prime}$ and $10^{\prime \prime}$
2. Place you cardstock back in the cutter portrait position at the $11 / 4 "$ mark and cut from the 2 " score mark to the $10^{\prime \prime}$ score mark.
3. Remove cardstock rotate and place back in your cutter at the $1 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime}$ mark and cut from the $2^{\prime \prime}$ score mark to the $10^{\prime \prime}$ score mark (as indicated in diagram by red solid line).
4. Then fold the card M is where the card creates the Mountain part of the fold and the V the valley. The center will be the opposite of the top and bottom.
5. Embellish as desired!
