### **Supplies**

### Stamps:

126695 Wetlands Wood Mount 126697 Wetlands Clear Mount

#### Paper:

101650 Very Vanilla (8 ½" x 5 ½")(2 ½" x 2 ¾") 120953 Crumb Cake ( 2 ½" x 3")

#### Ink:

101406 StazOn Ink – Jet Black 126975 Crumb Cake 131181 Soft Sky

#### Other:

133763 Gold Basic Metal Buttons 132140 1 ¼" Burlap Ribbon 118485 Block D Clear Mount Block 126185 Stampin' Spritzer (fill with water) 104430 Stampin' Dimensionals 103683 Glue Dot

#### Instructions

- 1. Fold Very Vanilla cardstock in half to create card front.
- 2. Ink up the Clear Mount Block with the Soft Sky ink (top) and Crumb Cake (bottom) by just tapping it on the block. Spritz with water.
- 3. Press this onto the small piece of Very Vanilla. Let dry thoroughly.
- 4. Stamp the Canada Goose in Jet Black StazOn ink on to the piece.
- 5. Glue piece to the Crumb Cake piece.
- 6. Pop up on the front of the card with Dimensionals.
- 7. Stamp the greeting on the lower right corner of the card with Jet Black StazOn ink.
- 8. Cut a 20" piece of Burlap Ribbon and cut off the sealed edge off of one side. Save this piece for Card #3. This will free up the burlap fibres. Just pull them to release them one by one.
- 9. Gather three or four of them and wrap around the left side of the card. Tie in knot.
- 10. Thread some other threads through the button and use a glue dot to secure on top of the fibres.
