

THE AMAZING 12 PAGES IN 12-MINUTES SCRAPBOOK

- (1) Sheet of 12 x 12 light colored cardstock
- (2) 8" x 6 3/4" light colored cardstock
- (6) 6" x 6" Page Protectors

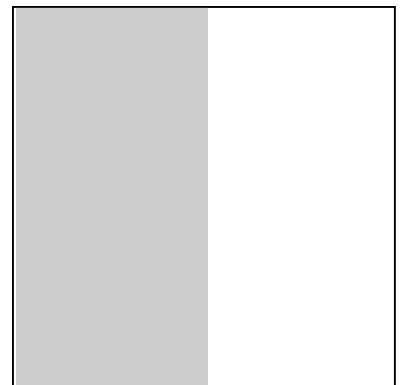
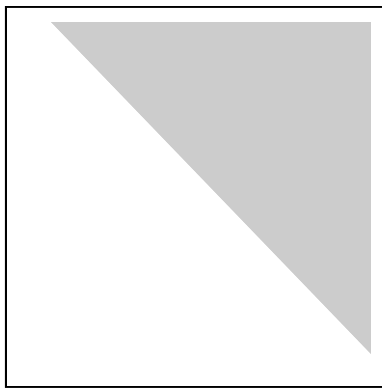
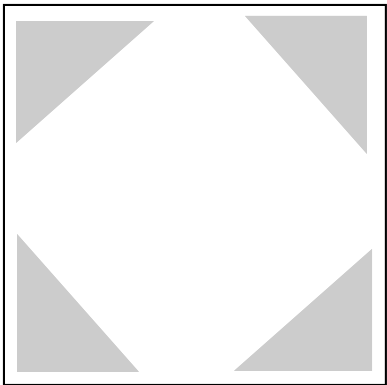
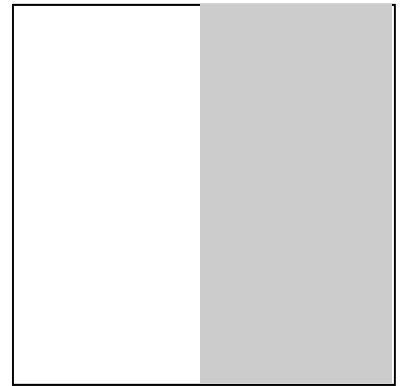
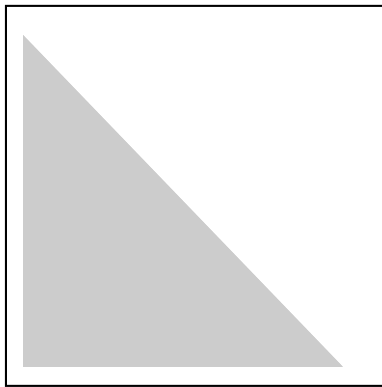
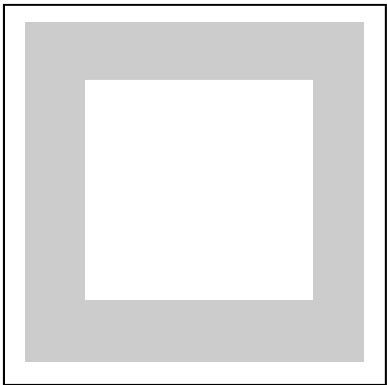
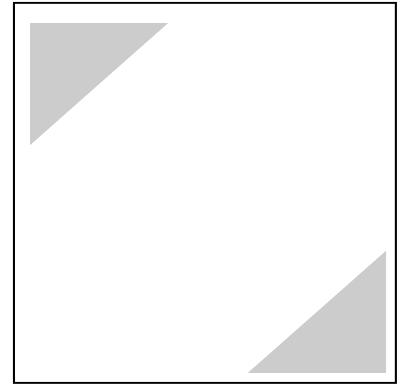
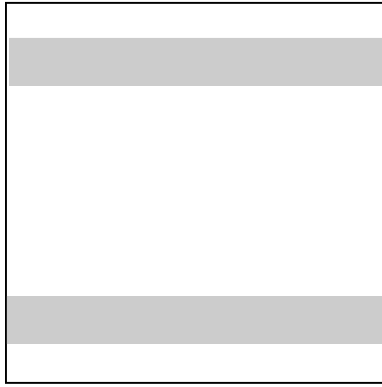
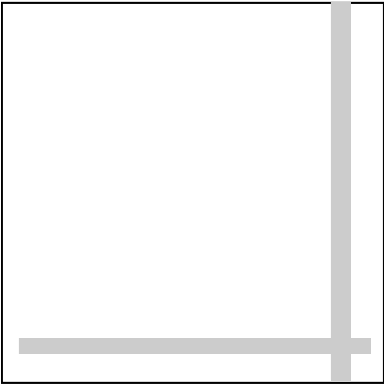
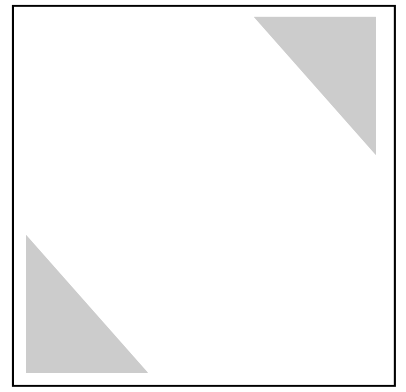
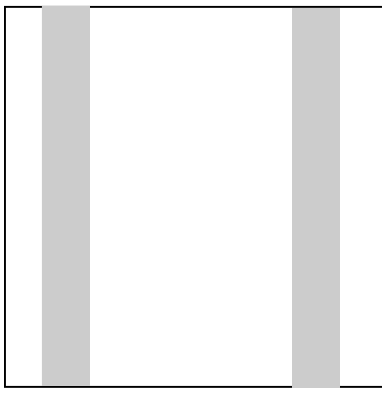
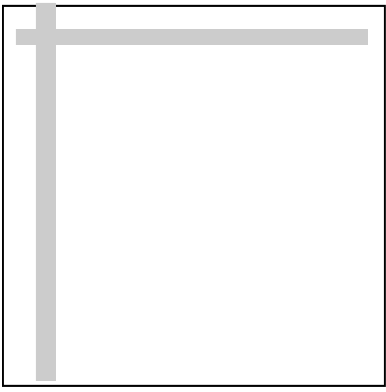
- (2) Sheets of 12 x 12 darker colored cardstock
- (4) 7" Ribbon
- Paper Trimmer

- Jumbo Wheel
- Snail Adhesive
- 1/4" hole punch

Cut the (2) sheets of darker cardstock into (8) 6" x 6" pages. Wheel on the front and back of the (2) 8" x 6 3/4" light colored cardstock pieces and score at 1 1/4" to create the "spine". Set aside. Wheel on the 12 x 12 lighter cardstock and cut into (4) 6" x 6" pages. Cut these (4) 6" x 6" pieces as shown in the diagram. Following the diagram on the back page, adhere pieces as shown to create (12) scrapbook pages.

COVER: Lay a page protector onto a 8" x 6 3/4" so that the fold in the page protector and the fold in the cover match up. Use a pencil to mark circles. Punch through both covers at the same time using a 1/4" hole punch. Tie the whole thing together using 2 pieces of 7" ribbon in each hole. Be careful not to tie them too tight or the book won't lie flat! Adhere the 2 remaining 6" x 6" pieces to the front cover and the inside of the back cover.
