This month's cards feature the Wetland Stamp Set.



Supplies

Stamps:

126695 Wetlands Wood Mount 126697 Wetlands Clear Mount

Paper:

101650 Very Vanilla (8 ½" x 5 ½")(2 ½" x 2 ¾" – 2 piece) 120953 Crumb Cake (2 ½" x 3")

Ink:

132708 Memento Pad Tuxedo Black 126975 Crumb Cake 131180 Pear Pizzazz 131181 Soft Sky

Other:

133763 Gold Basic Metal Buttons 132140 1 ¼" Burlap Ribbon 103954 Aqua Painters 119854 1 ¾" Scallop Circle Punch 104430 Stampin' Dimensionals 103683 Glue Dot

Instructions

- 1. Fold Very Vanilla cardstock in half to create card front.
- 2. Punch out a scallop from scrap piece of cardstock and use with Soft Sky ink and a sponge to create clouds on smaller Very Vanilla piece (see video for How To Make Clouds).
- 3. Stamp the Canada Goose in Memento Ink on the clouds.
- 4. Colour in the grass using an Agua Painter and Pear Pizzazz ink.
- 5. Stamp the Canada Goose in Memento Ink on the second piece of Very Vanilla and cut out image.
- 6. Colour the goose with Aqua Painter and Crumb Cake ink and pop up on top of the first goose using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 7. Glue piece to the Crumb Cake piece and pop up on the front of the card with Dimensionals.
- 8. Stamp the bull rushes in Crumb Cake on the lower right side of card and over-stamp the greeting with Memento Ink.
- 9. Cut a 20" piece of Burlap Ribbon and cut off the sealed edge off of one side. This will free up the burlap fibres. Just pull them to release them one by one.
- 10. Gather three or four of them and wrap around the left side of the card. Tie in knot.
- 11. Thread some other threads through the button and use a glue dot to secure on top of the fibres.
